GENERAL INFORMATION

Authors are invited to submit their research work as papers prepared in English. Submission implies willingness to register at the conference, pay the registration fee and present the paper in person or during virtual session. Sessions for Virtual Authors will be proceeded on video conference and scheduled in conference programme.

Papers will be included in the conference proceedings only if they review process and if at least one Author will register and pay the registration. Within each registration the Author can submit three papers.

Conference proceedings will be published in digital form after paper presentation (oral or virtual) and will be send to indexation in ISI Web of Science and Scopus databases. It is also expected to publish the best papers in extended form in journals of the JCR list (additionally paid).

All materials must be submitted electronically and prepared according to templates. The book of abstracts will be provided during the conference.

ABSTRACTS

Abstracts should be prepared in English and optionally in Polish or author's native language according to template (see webpage). The Authors will be informed about the acceptance of abstracts in two weeks since the submission. The decision about the form of presentation and final allocation to sessions will be based on the outcome of the review process.

Abstracts for review must clearly state:

- > The purpose of the work;
- > The manner and degree to which it advances the art;
- ➤ Specific new results that have been obtained and their significance.

Up to five main references should be added. Promises of upcoming results will be ignored.

PAPERS

Authors are kindly asked to prepare papers before styling, in two column arrangement. After the review they will be informed about the appropriate paper templates.

Notification of papers' acceptance will be sent in two weeks since the submission.
